Fr. Eloy Romero-Rojas was born in Caracas Venezuela, and ordained to the priesthood on March 17, 2000, in the Military Diocese of Venezuela. He resides in Fort Lee, New Jersey. Before coming to the United States, Fr. Romero-Rojas was a military chaplain for the Venezuelan Air Force. For twenty years has been traveling and preaching in parishes across the United States raising funds and generating awareness among U.S. Catholics for the downtrodden and neglected populations in the developing world. Cross Catholic Outreach was founded to create a meaningful link between parishes in America and the priests and nuns working in the Church overseas in the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Central and South America.


