We will again be supporting Thomas Jefferson Elementary School as they are the lowest-income elementary school in Louisa County. Restoration Ministries: This is to introduce you to Restoration Ministries (RM) a local charity supporting the needy in Louisa County and in Mataoka, West Virginia in the Appalachian Mountains. A town with less than 200 residents that is no longer incorporated, which means no public services, such as police, fire and rescue, and trash service. The town doesn't have a Mayor, doesn't have a school, no

playgrounds, no restaurants, and no stores. The poverty level according to the last comparison: West Virginia's poverty level is 16.9 % and Virginia's is 9.94%. As a Parish, we will continue to support RM by donating clothing and toiletries throughout the year.

Also, RM is hosting a Fundraising Event on August 24th from 11AM - 5PM at the Louisa County Fireman's Fairgrounds, 208 Fredericksburg Ave in Louisa. Please come for a day filled with live Inspirational Music, Games and Prizes, Food Trucks, Vendors, and a Live Auction. RM is asking for donations of Non-perishable foods and toiletries. All funds raised will go to the poverty stricken families in the Appalachian mountains of West Virginia.
