The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe and The First Sunday of Advent





On the last Sunday of each liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or **Christ the King**. Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.

On December 1st the Church will begin a new liturgical year, with Advent (from, "ad-venire" in Latin or "to come to") is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of <u>Christmas</u>. The Advent season is a time of **preparation** that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas. From the earliest days of the Church, people have been fascinated by Jesus' promise to come back. Note, the scripture readings during Advent tell us not to waste our time with predictions. Advent is not about speculation. **Our Advent readings call us to be alert and ready, not weighted down and distracted by the cares of this world.** 


