Please note that I.C. Bible Study typically meets on the **second Thursday of each month**. Below is the schedule for this summer:

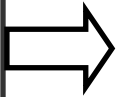
- **Thursday, May 29 – Topic: “Pentecost”** This is an additional class added to deepen our understanding of Pentecost
